


Primary

Uniform

I would like to clarify a few questions about uniform. We are transitioning our uniform from beige bottoms to black bottoms following a consultation with learners. It is perfectly fine for learners to continue to wear out the beige uniform and indeed the remaining stocks of beige items at TEK bookmart will continue to be sold off at a discount. However, all replacement stock will be in black. All the details of the uniform requirements are outlined in the parent handbook.

All sizes are currently available. IB skirts are currently available only in beige for the majority of sizes and black will be available in due course for the remaining sizes. Orders are currently taking 5-6 working days to arrive, this will soon drop to around 4 days once the peak period of the start of term is over.
